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SECTION 1: INVITATION TO TENDER

County government of Isiolo invites bids from eligible construction companies registered with the **National Constuction Authority (NCA)in Category NCA 8 and Above the ROUTINE MAINTENANCE AND SPOT IMPROVEMENT CONTRACT FOR JN A2 - KM 2+000 ROAD** to be funded by County Government of Isiolo.

SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of works shall be as described in the tender document.

QUALIFICATION FOR TENDERING

A. FINANCIAL EVALUATION

32 COMPARISON OF MAJOR RATES OF ITEMS OF CONSTRUCTION OR CREDIBILITY OF TENDERERS RATES.

The Employer will compare the tenderers' rates with the Engineer's estimates for major items of construction. If some bids are seriously unbalanced or front loaded in relation to the Engineer's estimates for the major items of work to be performed under the contract, the Employer may require the bidder to produce detailed price analyses for any or all items of the Bills of Quantities, to demonstrate the internal consistency of those prices with the construction methods and schedule proposed. **The bidder shall within four (4) days after issuance of the written notice by the employer, or such further time as the employer may allow, provide a satisfactory analysis failure to which the tender shall be rejected.**

33 PREFERENCE FOR DOMESTIC BIDDERS

This will not be applicable for this bid.

B. AWARD OF CONTRACT

34 AWARD

- 34.1 Subject to Clause 31, the Employer will award the contract to the bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive to the bidding documents and who has offered the lowest Evaluated Bid Price pursuant to Clause 19, provided that such bidder has been determined to be (a) eligible in accordance with the provisions of Sub-Clause 3.1, and (b) qualified in accordance with the provisions of Clause 4.

35 EMPLOYER'S RIGHT TO ACCEPT ANY BID AND TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS

- 35.1 The Employer reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids, at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders or any obligation to inform the affected bidder or bidders of the grounds for the Employer's action.

36 NOTIFICATION OF AWARD

- 36.1 Prior to expiration of the period of bid validity prescribed by the Employer, the Employer will notify the successful bidder in writing or by cable confirmed by registered letter that its bid has been accepted. This letter (hereinafter and in the Conditions of Contract called "Letter of Acceptance") shall specify the sum, which the Employer will pay the Contractor in consideration of the execution and completion of the works and the remedying of any defects therein by the Contractor as prescribed by the contract (hereinafter and in the Conditions of Contract called "the Contract Price").
- 36.2 At the same time that the Employer notifies the successful bidder that his bid has been accepted, the Employer shall notify the other bidders that their bids have been unsuccessful and that their bid security will be returned as promptly as possible, in accordance with sub clause 17.4.

37 SIGNING OF AGREEMENT

- 37.1 Within 11 days of receipt of the notification of award, the successful bidder shall sign the Form of Agreement and return it to the Employer, together with the required performance security.
- 37.2 Within 18 days of issuance of the notification of award, the Employer shall sign the Form of Agreement as received from the contractor.

38 CONTRACT EFFECTIVENESS

- 38.1 The Contract will be effective only upon signature of the Agreement between the Contractor and the Employer.

- Left Side (Shoulder):**
 - See NOTE 4:** Dimension for the leftmost shoulder area.
 - Type 2 control:** Dimension for the first control zone on the left.
 - Type 3 control:** Dimension for the second control zone on the left.
 - 6.0m:** Width of the paved shoulder area.
- Vegetation Free Zone:**
 - VEGETATION FREE ZONE (Type 5 control):** The central unpaved area.
 - 6.0m:** Width of the vegetation free zone.
- Right Side (Shoulder and Drainage):**
 - Edgeline:** The boundary between the paved shoulder and the vegetation free zone.
 - Centreline:** The center of the road.
 - Edge marker:** A post marking the edge of the paved area.
 - 0.5m:** Distance from the edge marker to the edge of the paved area.
 - Surface water channel:** A channel for runoff, with a width of **1.0m**.
 - See NOTE 1:** Dimension for the rightmost shoulder area.
 - Side Drain:** A drainage structure on the far right.
 - Type 4 control:** Dimension for the control zone adjacent to the side drain.
 - approx. 1.5m:** Approximate width of the control zone adjacent to the side drain.
 - See NOTE 4:** Dimension for the rightmost shoulder area.
- General Notes:**
 - See NOTE 3:** Dimension for the total width of the paved shoulder area (6.0m + 3.0m min).
 - Extent of control on some urban highways:** Indicated by a bracket on the right side.
 - Extent of control on some non-urban highways:** Indicated by a bracket on the far right.

NOTE 1 this distance must be a minimum of 3.0m on straights and on the outside of curves and a minimum of 5.0m on the inside of curves.

NOTE 2 Vegetation free zone must be maintained free of all vegetation.

SECTION 3: BILLS OF QUANTITIES

PREAMBLE TO BILL OF QUANTITIES

1. The Bills of Quantities forms part of the Contract Documents and are to be read in conjunction with the Instructions to Bidders, Conditions of Contract Parts I and II, Specifications and Drawings.
1. The brief description of the items in the Bills of Quantities is purely for the purpose of identification, and in no way modifies or supersedes the detailed descriptions given in the conditions of Contract and Specifications for the full direction and description of work and materials.
3. The Quantities set forth in the Bills of Quantities are estimated , representing substantially the work to be carried out, and are given to provide a common basis for bidding and comparing of Bids. There is no guarantee to the Contractor that he will be required to carry out all the quantities of work indicated under any one particular item or group of items in the Bill of Quantities. The basis of payment shall be the Contractor's rates and the quantities of work actually done in fulfilment of his obligation under the Contract.
4. The prices and rates inserted in the Bills of Quantities will be used for valuing the work executed, and the Engineer will only measure the whole of the works executed in accordance with this Contract.
5. A price or rate shall be entered in ink against every item in the Bills of Quantities with the exception of items that already have Provisional sums affixed thereto. The bidders are reminded that no “nil” or “included” rates or “lump-sum” discounts will be accepted. The rates for various items should include discounts if any. Bidders who fail to comply will be disqualified.
6. Provisional sums (including Dayworks) in the Bills of Quantities shall be expended in whole or in part at the discretion of the Engineer.

The price and rates entered in the Bills of Quantities shall, except insofar as it is otherwise provided under the Contract, include all Constructional plant to be used, labour, insurance, supervision, compliance testing, materials, erection, maintenance of works, overheads and profits, taxes and duties together with all general risks, liabilities and obligations set out or implied in the Contract, transport, electricity and telephones, water, use and replenishment of all consumables, including those required under the contract by the Engineer and his staff.
